Students at Hilliard SS continue to make great gains in Maths and we pay some of the credit to the use of Mathletics for supporting this. In 2014, students at Hilliard SS have achieved close to 2500 certificates including close to 4.5 million activity points and over 200 000 Live points.

We strongly encourage students to work towards 1000 points each week, gaining them a new certificate each week. Parents can help by making time, and encouraging their child, to access Mathletics at home, family or friends or even local library.
