- I can show commitment to my team by attending training, trying my best and supporting others.
- I understand that inappropriate behaviour or failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in my position on the team being reviewed.

Parent and Community Code of Conduct

As a parent/carer or supporter of H.S.S. Inter-School Sport:

- I can communicate respectfully with players, staff, officials and spectators.
- I can support team officials in providing a safe and positive sporting environment.
- I can encourage teamwork, effort, fair play and positive sportsmanship.
- I can respect referees, umpires, opposing teams and supporters.
- I can model respectful behaviour, including online and through digital communication.
