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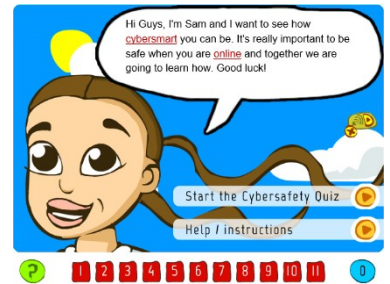
## Cybersafety School Plan

Classes at Hilliard SS should have on display, and teachers discuss with students, some or all of the following posters (relevant to their year level):

- ✓ Internet Safety Golden Rules Poster
- ✓ Cybersafety Statement
- ✓ Cybersafety SAFE
- ✓ Think Before You Post Online
- ✓ All Digital Citizens
- ✓ iPad care and maintenance for younger kids
- ✓ iPad care and maintenance for older kids
- ✓ **HIP Charter** (regularly review of aspects of the HIP Charter with students).

By the end of Week 3, Term 1, explicit teaching episodes should occur and the following topics should be considered:

1. What is a Digital Citizen? What are our digital rights and responsibilities?
2. Internet Safety
3. Cyberbullying
4. Netiquette
5. Digital Footprint
6. Plagiarism
7. How can we communicate what we understand about being a digital citizen to the rest of the school? Design a poster for what we have learnt.
