## This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or above in English – Target of 85%
- Increase access to Speech Language services within the early years reflecting on our Early Start, Diagnostic Reading Data and Read Write Inc data.
- Strengthen teacher and teacher aide capacity reflecting on best practice within the areas of Reading
- Provide financial and human resources to support Guided Reading opportunities across the school to lead to an increase in our Reading data.
- Strengthen Positive Engagement for Learning across the school

## Our initiatives include

- Participation in the Leading Learning Collaborative strengthening our knowledge and use of Lynn Sharratt's *Clarity* work
- Introduction of synthetic phonics process – Read Write Inc – to improve our phonics and reading in the Early Years
- Providing targeted intervention through our School Coach and trained Teacher Aides in response to students identified using the Case Management Process.
- Providing targeted support for students who require adjustments in the classroom with their engagement with the curriculum.
- Strengthen teacher and teacher aide capacity to provide explicit learning opportunities within the area of reading and synthetic phonics.
- Involvement in the Regional collaborative with a focus on “The Inclusive Teaching of Reading” utilising the skills and research from the Speech Pathologist service.
