### It is <u>unacceptable</u> for students at Hilliard State School to:

- use an iPad, mobile phone or other devices in an unlawful manner

- use language and/or threats of violence that may amount to bullying and/or harassment, or even stalking
- insult, harass or attack others or use obscene or abusive language
- deliberately waste internet resources, damage computers, printers or network equipment
- commit plagiarism or violate copyright laws
- it is unacceptable for students at Hilliard State School to use social media whilst at school
- knowingly download viruses or any other programs capable of breaching the department's network security
- use device cameras anywhere a normal camera would be considered inappropriate, such as in change rooms or toilets
- invade someone's privacy by recording personal conversations or daily activities and/or the further distribution (e.g. forwarding, texting, uploading) of such material
- use ipads before or after school hours or while travelling
